Network Rail is proud to offer you a range of pension options to meet your needs and provide flexibility in those options as you progress your career with us.

If you're a member of either the NRDC (defined contribution), or CARE (career average) pension schemes you may be considering joining the RPS after five years' continuous company service.

This is a one-off opportunity all employees receive on completing five years' continuous company service.

The changes being made to the Network Rail Section of the RPS on 1 July 2012 will mean that you will still be able to join the RPS after five years if you wish, by taking up the option when it is offered to you.

If you reach five years' company service before 1 July you will have been given the option of joining the RPS. If you accepted the invitation to join the RPS, you will be given a one-off option to change to the RPS 65 terms.

If you reach five years' service on or after 1 July, you will retain the option to join the RPS, but this will be under the RPS 65 terms only.
